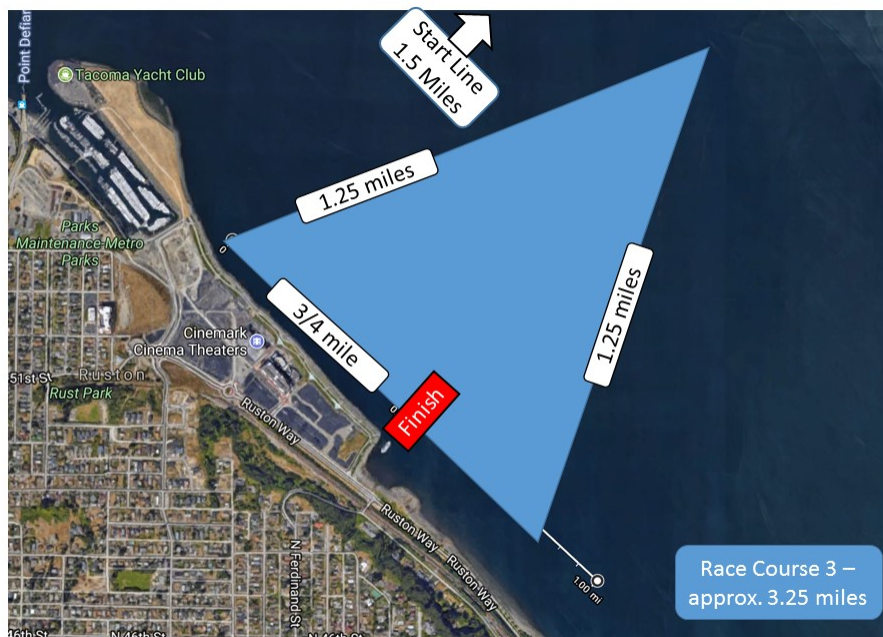

Opening Ceremony

This will be held at Delta Marine at 4.30pm – 6.30pm on Friday 28th July. Delta Marine is located at 1608 S. 96th Street in Seattle. Maps & directions will be available at the Hyatt Hotel and will also be given to the Team Captains at their first meeting on 27th July.

Closing Ceremony and Final Presentation

This will be held at the Hyatt Hotel on Lake Washington on Sunday 6th August. It will be a brunch and will be a ticketed event. The event will run from 10.30am to 1pm. Each team will receive one ticket per official team member. Please contact your team captain to arrange for additional tickets.

Race and association officials will receive one event ticket as well. Please contact Kelly Ireland (mobile [714-264-7858](tel:714-264-7858)) for additional tickets. Tickets will be \$100 USD and must be purchased no later than August 1st.

Boat Storage

There is a secure area available at Pt Ruston which will be exclusive for competitor's boats etc. This area will be secure and boats can be left there overnight from 28th July through 5th August. This will be right next to the waterfront where the races are and near the launch area. This is the only area near the race site where teams will be able to park their boat and tow vehicle.

Your team captains will have order forms for tents which can be rented for the entire time that the pits are open.

The pits will be open from the 28th July and close on the 5th August after the event.



Fueling

A Fuel supplier has been arranged and there will be a secure area at Pt Ruston where fuel will be dropped for teams. This is where teams will be able to fuel up on race days. We can get fuel delivered there within 24 hours. Please provide your team captains with your fuel requirements for each race day and type of fuel needed. You team captain will have a spreadsheet and requires teams to give them details on how many gallons of fuel they will need.

Rental Tow Vehicles / Rental Cars

Rental cars are available from all the standard rental car companies. Please make your reservations directly via the rental car company websites (i.e., Hertz, National, Payless, Alamo, Fox, Sixt, Enterprise, Budget, Dollar, Avis...). All those listed above are available at Seattle's SeaTac International Airport, as well as many regional locations throughout Puget Sound. Make reservations early as this is a very busy time of year in this area.

Transport

There will be a shuttle service running from the official hotel to the race venue each race day. This will depart at approx. 9am from the hotel and then return after the races are completed in the afternoon. You team captain will have details of the cost for this. Please advise them of your interest in booking this as spaces will be limited.

Insurance

Competitors Insurance has been arranged and this will be provided through the National Water Ski Racing Association (NWSRA) and USA Waterski. This will be a complimentary event membership to participants of foreign federations. You must provide complete paperwork and sign a waiver, but will not be charged a membership fee for competing in the World Championships. This can be arranged at registration and all paperwork will be available there.

Team Registration

Registration will be held at the host Hyatt Hotel in Renton. Times are scheduled on the 26th July from 12pm – 4pm and 27th July from 8am – 12pm.

During registration, maps and details of where the boat launch and parking areas are will be provided.

Sunfest and Pt Ruston
